

## **GTFC Impact Phase III Competition Protocols**

In addition to items listed below GTFC Impact will be following the Responsible RestartOhio released by the ODH for Youth, Collegiate, Amateur, Club and Professional Sports.

### **Players and Coaches:**

- Players and coaches must conduct daily symptom assessments before each practice or game.
- Anyone experiencing any symptoms must stay home.
- Coaches will wear face coverings at all times and players will wear face coverings when not on the field of play.
- Players will be sure to have all bags lined up 6 feet apart during the game and be sure to be sitting 6 feet apart with masks on while not on the field of play.
- No congregating for long periods of time before or after the game by players, coaches, managers or parents.
- Coaches and players will promote good hand hygiene before and after games. Players will be sure to use their own hand sanitizer or some provided by a coach or wash hands in restroom right after the game before enter their car to head home.
- At the conclusion of the match players and coaches will not shake hands with the other team but rather clap for them and the parents on the field while maintain social distance from all.
- Players will gather their belongs and head straight to the exits/parking lot to leave the field/facility with parents.

### **Parents/Spectators**

- Parents and spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments before each practice or game.
- Anyone experiencing any symptoms must stay home.

- Parents/Spectators will sit on the same side as the team. Parents will sit 10 feet back of the line and be social distanced between families.
- Family members must sit together and be socially distanced from other individuals/families.
- No congregating before or after games is permitted.
- Parents and spectators must wear face coverings at all times except for any of the allowable exceptions stated in the Director's Order for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio.
- At the end of the game all parents and spectators will leave the field or venue immediately and wait for their player by their car or near the parking lot. This so we can clear the field for the next teams to use and be sure to give the staff or facility time to sanitize any common used areas by parents or spectators.

### **Venue:**

- If we are ever close to a capacity issue at a location because of guidelines set by the facility, extended family members will be asked to leave first and 2 parents/guardians will be allowed to remain.
- At the end of the match parents will exit the venue and wait for players outside of their cars or near the parking lot. Parents will not wait at the field for players after the game.

### **Equipment**

- Equipment and personal items must have proper separation and must not be shared. If equipment must be shared, proper sanitation must be performed between users.
- Do not share towels or facial coverings.
- Do not share water bottles, other drinks or food.
- Players will not share pennies or other items.
- Coaches will set up and pick up cones, players are not to handle any equipment that is not theirs.

- Coaches, team manager or compliance officer will be sure to wipe down all common equipment at the conclusion of a game.

**Compliance Officer:**

- A compliance officer representing the team will be at each event and be made aware before the start of each game to the official and opposing teams.
- If something were to happen during the course of the game that the compliance officer would need to report, they will do so in accordance with GTFC Impact compliance officers procedures and policies and report it directly to club's compliance officer.
